**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-10
ESTABLISHING BUILDING SAFETY COMMITTEE**

The Second Judicial District Court (“SJDC”), as part of the state constitutional judicial system, “has the inherent power to protect itself and to administer its affairs.” *City of N. Las Vegas ex re. Arndt v. Daines*, 92 Nev. 292, 294, 550 P.2d 399, 400 (1976). The Chief Judge of the SJDC has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court. (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c)). The Chief Judge shall appoint committees of the court. WDCR 2(5). The Chief Judge has decided that a committee regarding Courthouse safety, in all aspects, should be appointed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Building Safety Committee is hereby established for the purpose of ongoing investigation, evaluation, and recommendations for the safe and secure operation and use of the Washoe County Courthouse located at 75 Court Street, Reno, NV (“Courthouse”).

2. Judge Kathleen M. Drakulich, Judge Lynne K. Jones, and Judge Tammy M. Riggs are hereby appointed to serve on the Building Safety Committee.
3. The Building Safety Committee’s responsibilities shall include but not be limited to investigation and evaluation of the following:
 - a. Environmental
 - b. Safety
 - c. Americans with Disabilities Act
 - d. Structural
 - e. Earthquake
 - f. Fire
 - g. Water
 - h. Air Quality
 - i. Any other conditions or circumstances relevant to the Building Safety Committee’s purpose.
4. The Building Safety Committee shall undertake investigations, evaluations and make recommendations to the Chief Judge at regular intervals or as necessary regarding resolution of any issues regarding safety and use of the Courthouse by employees, attorneys and parties participating in court business, members of the general public and others entering the Courthouse.
