ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-11

The Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District Court (“Court”) has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court. WDCR 2(2); NRS 3.025(2)(c). The Court will be transitioning to a new electronic case management system. This transition will occur May 1 through May 4, 2026. To accommodate this transition, the following is ordered:

- (1) The Court’s electronic filing system, eFlex, will be unavailable beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 30, 2026. No filings will be electronically accepted after this time. Any users remaining logged into eFlex after 6:00 p.m. on April 30, 2026, will be logged out of the system regardless of whether their transactions have been completed. eFlex will be unavailable until 8:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4, 2026.

(2) No filings will be accepted on Friday, May 1, 2026. For the purposes of deadlines only, May 1, 2026, will be considered a non-judicial day. Any documents due on May 1, 2026, will be deemed to be timely if filed by Monday, May 4, 2026. For the purposes of timelines, May 1, 2026, will otherwise be considered a judicial day and should be included in calculations.


(3) The Court Resource Center will be available on Friday, May 1, 2026, for very limited purposes. No filings will be accepted and specific case information will be unavailable.

(4) The Court Protection Order Help Center will remain open on Friday, May 1, 2026, to accept and process applications for temporary protection.

(5) Counsel shall provide courtesy hard copies of any document filed on Thursday, April 30, 2026, that relate to any hearing occurring between May 4, 2026, and May 8, 2026. Courtesy copies can be dropped off at the Court Resource Center on the third floor of 1 South Sierra Street.

This Administrative Order shall remain in effect until May 4, 2026, or until specifically modified or rescinded by subsequent administrative order.
