**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-14**

The Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District Court (“Court”) has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court. WDCR 2(2); NRS 3.025(2)(c).

On May 1, 2026, the Court began transitioning its systems to a new case management system (see Administrative Order 2026-11). All systems, including electronic filing, were anticipated to be fully restored by 8:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4, 2026. However, throughout Monday, May 4, 2026, electronic filing has been intermittently unavailable. In light of this unavailability, the following is ordered:


- (1) For the purposes of deadlines only, May 1-4, 2026, will be considered non-judicial days. Any documents that were due May 1-4, 2026, will be considered timely filed if filed by May 5, 2026.

(2) The District Court's Resource Center is directed to stamp and file any document presented in-person, even if presented by a party who is otherwise subject to mandatory electronic filing.
