ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-16

The Chief Judge of the SJDC has authority to make administrative decisions
pertaining to the business of the Court. WDCR 2(2); NRS 3.025(2)(c).

The Rules of Practice for the Second Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada
(WDCR) use the term “master” to refer to a judicial officer who performs certain duties.

A.B. 344, 83rd Leg. (Nev. 2025) replaces the term “master” with the term “judicial
officer” and authorizes the court to designate a different title to a person appointed as a
judicial officer, so long as the title does not include the term “master.”

Pursuant to A.B. 344, 83rd Leg. (Nev. 2025), the SJDC will replace the term “master”
with the term “commissioner.”
