ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-19

The Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District Court ("Court") has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court. WDCR 2(2); NRS 3.025(2)(c).

The Court utilizes eFlex to accept electronic filings. In addition, eFlex is the primary portal for litigants and attorneys to access their case files. At approximately 12:30 p.m. on August 5, 2026, eFlex became unavailable. Services through eFlex are not anticipate to be restored until Friday, August 7, 2026. In light of this unavailability, the following is ordered:

- (1) For the purposes of deadline calculations, August 6, 2026, will be considered non-judicial day.

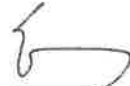
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1 (2) The District Court's Resource Center is directed to stamp and file any document
