## <u>ORDER</u>

Parties receiving mediation services pay fees pursuant to NRS 3.500(2)(e) and the Fee Policy of the Family Division. The existing fee policy for mediation is modified as follows:

| Combined Income      | Total Fee | Each Party Pays | Per Hour (@ 5.0 hours) |
|----------------------|-----------|-----------------|------------------------|
| Less than \$15,000   | 100.00    | 50.00           | 10.00                  |
| \$15,000 to \$25,000 | 200.00    | 100.00          | 20.00                  |
| \$25,000 to \$35,000 | 300.00    | 150.00          | 30.00                  |
| More than \$35,000   | 400.00    | 200.00          | 40.00                  |

There is also a charge of \$100 for telephone mediations (\$50 for each party). Voluntary cases pay the appropriate 'per hour' rate for their income group for services.

Note: In post-divorce cases and paternity actions each party's income is considered separately in determining fees.

This policy is effective for all referral orders signed after May 1, 2002.
