## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING CONDITIONAL RELEASE OF JUVENILES

Effective May 25, 2006, as an alternative to detention and absent statutory

mandates providing otherwise, children who are arrested and brought to Wittenberg Hall

for detention in the Jan Evans Center, and who have not already been approved for

release, may be conditionally released by Washoe County Department of Juvenile

Services until the next scheduled detention hearing in the following circumstances:

- The juvenile scores between 9 and 11 on the Court Approved Risk Assessment Instrument; and
- The juvenile is conditionally released on either house arrest or electronic monitoring house arrest; and
- The juvenile and the juvenile's parents accept the terms of the house arrest/electronic-monitoring contract; and
- 4. The juvenile and the juvenile's parents commit to appear at the next scheduled detention hearing and are given written notice of the hearing date.

Conditional release is an extension of detention. Any violation of the conditional

release agreement will be considered an escape.
