STANDING ORDER AUTHORIZING SHARING OF INFORMATION

This Order is made to facilitate the communication and sharing of information between Washoe County School District, Washoe County Department of Social Services and the Second Judicial District Court, Family Division, in conjunction with the Initiative to Improve Educational Outcomes for Foster Children.

The Court finds that it is in the best interest of children to receive an appropriate education and that timely sharing of information will help reduce the unmet education needs of children in the Court's dependency system.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Washoe County Department of Social Services shall disclose to appropriate Washoe County School District personnel and / or appropriate Initiative to Improve Educational Outcomes for Foster Children personnel any relevant information concerning children in foster care which will aid in identifying the child and locating educational information. This information may include, but is not limited to, name, date of birth, social security number, address, placement, care provider, special needs and dependent status.

Washoe County School District shall disclose to appropriate Initiative to Improve Educational Outcomes for Foster Children personnel and / or Washoe County Department of

Social Services all relevant information regarding a child in foster care. This information may include, but is not limited to, names and addresses of educational providers, grade level performance, attendance records, discipline history, start and leave dates, class schedules, educational testing scores, any Individual Educational Plans (IEP), SSI or 504 information, behavioral intervention plans, psych-ed reports, special education program reports or plans or any notations by educators.

The disclosure of educational records by the Washoe County School District pursuant to this Order shall be deemed in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, provided that the Washoe County School District makes a reasonable effort to notify the parent or guardian of a child in foster care prior to the disclosure so that the parent or guardian may seek protective action.

Information or records exchanged pursuant to this Order may be transmitted electronically.

Information exchanged pursuant to this Order will be disclosed in conjunction with reporting to the Court on both the educational status of specific children in foster care as well as the overall educational status of dependent children.

Any person permitted access to information pursuant to this Order shall maintain the confidentially of the records and information and shall not permit further disclosure or release of the information except as necessary for reporting to the Court, offering of services to facilitate the educational progress of dependent children or unless such disclosure is authorized by this Order.

This Order shall not be interpreted to permit access to or release of records protected under any other state or federal law except as provided in those statutes.
