17 There presently exists family related cases, i.e., divorces, custody/visitation, etc. that
18 were initiated prior to the creation of the Family Court Division. These cases were
19 randomly assigned to all the District Court Departments including those that exist in
20 General Jurisdiction.

21 These cases can reach disposition but are subject to motion activity during their lifetime.
22 Currently, when a family related case, initiated prior to the inception of the Family
23 Division, is re-opened it is directed to the Department of original designation including
24 Department's 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 within General Jurisdiction. The District Judge of
25 that Department will then prepare an order transferring the case to the Family Division.


27 In order to provide a more efficient manner in which to transfer those cases to Family
28 Division, the following shall be implemented: Upon the re-opening of a family related

14 Judge Weller.


15 Canon 3E(1) of the Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct, in pertinent part, provides:
16 "a Judge shall disqualify himself or herself in a proceeding in which the Judge's
17 impartiality might be reasonably questioned..."

18 Canon 2 requires a Judge to avoid the appearance of impropriety.

19 In these unique circumstances and following discussion with my colleagues, the
20 Court directs the Clerk of the Court to assign no case to Department 11 in which a party
21 is represented by or is a member of the firm of Laub & Laub. This direction shall remain
22 in effect until modified.
