ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-09

WHEREAS, in Administrative Order 08-07, one judicial department was designated as the Child Dependency Department; and

WHEREAS, Department 2 has been designated the Child Dependency Department in place of Department 5; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for ease of administration to transfer Department 5's case load (both open and closed cases) to Department 2 and to transfer Department 2's case load (both open and closed cases) to Department 5.

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Effective December 1, 2014, all open and closed case types currently in Department 5 shall be transferred to Department 2.
- 2. Effective December 1, 2014, all open and closed case types currently in Department 2, except as specifically retained by Department 2 on a case-by-case basis to meet

the "one family, one judge" policy of the Second Judicial District Court, shall be transferred to Department 5.

- 3. SCR 48.4 provides that a peremptory challenge may be filed "within 3 days after the party or his attorney is notified that the case has been assigned to a judge." Notice shall be provided by the posting of this Administrative Order on the Court's website; posting this Administrative Order with other legal notices within both Court buildings; and by causing notice to be published via email by the Washoe County Bar Association. The 3 day time deadline shall be on or by December 10, 2014.
- 4. The Presiding Judge may develop internal protocols, organizational restructuring, and court master assignments to implement this Order.
- 5. This Administrative Order shall be in effect until specifically modified or rescinded by subsequent Administrative Order.
