ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2015-07

WHEREAS, Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters may perform specified duties within the Family Division and Juvenile Court upon specific appointment from the Presiding Judge of the Family Division;

WHEREAS, Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters serve or expect to serve once or only sporadically on a part-time basis under a separate appointment for each period of service or each case heard. See Application IV(A); Opinion: JE04-003 (citing Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct - Terminology);

WHEREAS, in Opinion: JE04-003 the Standing Committee on Judicial Ethics found that use of attorneys as masters on a sporadic basis, with an average of five and no more than twelve appointments per year, fit the definition of a Pro Tempore Part-Time Master within the meaning of Application IV(A);

WHEREAS, Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters are precluded from acting as a lawyer in a proceeding in which they have served as a master or in any other proceeding related thereto. <u>See</u> Opinion: JE04-003;

WHEREAS, Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters are not precluded from practicing law in the Court on which the masters serve;

WHEREAS, Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters are subject to the same educational requirements as full-time masters set forth in ADKT 251, NRS 62B.020, and ADKT 168 (training for masters handling domestic violence matters) as applicable;

WHEREAS, the Family Division requires a pool of attorneys who meet the qualification and education requirements to serve as Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters from which to make the sporadic specific appointments;

WHEREAS, the Family Division shall accept applications to be eligible for Pro Tempore Part-Time Master appointment during the month of June in every even year beginning June 1, 2016, and any other time deemed necessary by the Presiding Judge of the Family Division; and

WHEREAS, the current pool of attorneys eligible for specific appointment as Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters is comprised of those attorneys appointed as Special Masters by Administrative Order 2014-03;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Patricia Halstead, Esq., and Kathleen Noneman, Esq., are eligible for specific appointment as Pro Tempore Part-Time Masters.
- The above-named attorneys eligible for appointment as Pro Tempore Part-Time
 Masters shall serve only upon specific appointment.
- 4. The Presiding Judge may develop internal protocols, organizational restructuring, and court master assignments to implement this Order.
- 3. This Administrative Order specifically modifies Administrative Order 2014-03.
- 4. This Administrative Order shall remain in effect until modified by a subsequent Administrative Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
