ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2015-09

WHEREAS, in 2010, the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges began work on the Multi-Court Collaboration Initiative, now known as Project ONE, to provide judges with guidance in supporting the needs of families and children; and

WHEREAS, the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges adopted the central concept of One Family One Judge to the Project ONE Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court adopted the Project ONE Initiative in July 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court instituted a Project ONE docket to address the needs of juveniles who have a petition filed in both a delinquency and dependency case; and

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court is committed to providing outstanding service to children, families, and its stakeholders; and

WHEREAS, allowing families and children to attend court hearings with One Judge is believed to improve collaborative and holistic services to children; and

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court has determined that it is in the best interest of its users to be seen by One Judge throughout their Court involvement; and

1 WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court has determined that it is in the best interest
2 of families who have an open dependency case to be seen by One Judge for related family cases;¹
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court has determined that it may be in the best
5 interest of families who have an open dependency case to be seen by One Judge for some related
6 civil and criminal cases; and

7 WHEREAS the Second Judicial District Court has authorized Judge Egan Walker to
8 develop a pilot program to determine when it is appropriate for families who have an open
9 dependency case to be seen by One Judge for some related civil and criminal cases.

10 NOW THEREFORE, Judge Egan Walker shall develop a pilot program to determine when
11 it is appropriate for families who have an open dependency case to be seen by One Judge for some
12 related civil and criminal cases. This pilot program may result in the assignment of some related
13 civil and criminal cases to Judge Egan Walker with the consent of the judge to whom the case was
14 originally assigned. Judge Egan Walker shall report the results of this pilot program to the Second
15 Judicial District Court Bench at the 2016 Judges' Retreat.

16 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

17 Judge Egan Walker shall develop a pilot program to determine when it is appropriate for
18 families who have an open dependency case to be seen by One Judge for some related civil and
19 criminal cases. This pilot program may result in the assignment of some related civil and criminal
20 cases to Judge Egan Walker with the consent of the judge to whom the case was originally
21 assigned. Judge Egan Walker shall report the results of this pilot program to Second Judicial
22 District Court Bench at the 2016 Judges' Retreat.
