## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-09

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 211.240, the Sheriff of Washoe County has submitted an application to the Chief Judge of the District requesting to release certain inmates;

WHEREAS, in this application, the Sheriff has represented that the Detention Facility is in danger of exceeding its operational capacity as defined by NRS 211.240(7);

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 211.240(2), the undersigned Chief Judge has consulted with Judge Dorothy Nash Holmes, Reno Municipal Court, who has been designated by the Municipal Courts for the County as the Judge to be so consulted, and has consulted with Justice of the Peace Pete Sferrazza, Reno Justice Court, who has been designated by the Justices of the Peace for the County as the Judge to be so consulted;

Good cause appearing,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Sheriff is authorized to release from custody inmates from the Washoe County Detention Facility in order to relieve overcrowding, provided those inmates qualify for early release under the conditions set forth in NRS 211.240(4) and (5).
- 2. Excluded from this release order are those inmates being held for Department of Parole and Probation holds, or on charges in the following categories: homicide, all sexual offenses, violation of protective orders, all domestic violence offenses, weapons offenses, and felony DUI offenses.
- 3. The authority herein granted to the Sheriff of Washoe County shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
