MATTERS AND ELECTION JUDGE ASSIGNMENT

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-11

WHEREAS the District Court has determined to remain open to adjudicate emergency election disputes during the 2016 general election on November 8, 2016, and

WHEREAS the interests of justice are advanced if the same judge hears all election disputes arising between election-day and the certification of the elections, and

WHEREAS the Chief Judge is responsible for the administrative processes of the court, and

WHEREAS in prior contested election cases, the clerk's minutes and court reporter's notes have been required by reviewing courts and have proven invaluable to the parties and public in understanding the process and will assist the Clerk of Court, the judicial officer assigned to the case(s), the parties, counsel and public,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Chief Judge directs the Clerk of Court to open the court filing office at 7:00 a.m. November 8, 2016, and not close the filing office on that day until the last polling location in Washoe County has closed.

- 2. During the extended hours of operation, the Clerk of Court must only accept filings related to the 2016 election.
- 3. The Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District Court, in his administrative capacity, will serve as the 2016 Election Judge.
- 4. If a matter is filed or heard on November 8, 2016, after regular business hours, the matter will be clerked by an assigned court clerk and reported by a reporter selected by the Election Judge. The JAVS recording system may be utilized in the place of a court reporter.
- 5. All matters shall be heard by the Election Judge on the record; no ex parte decisions will be entered by the Election Judge unless supported by exigent circumstances.
- 6. The Election Judge will preside over all election contests that are filed between November 8, 2016, and the day after the last date any election on the 2016 general election ballot are certified.
- 7. This administrative order shall be in effect until March 31, 2017, or until specifically modified of rescinded by subsequent administrative order.
