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15 **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2017-05**

16 WHEREAS, the Conference of Chief Justices (CCJ) and the Conference of State
17 Court Administrators (COSCA) have identified routine mandatory security training as
18 being essential in increasing court security and emergency preparedness;¹ and

19 WHEREAS, the CCJ and COSCA instructed that security drills for all who work
20 in a court facility are an important part of mandatory security training (*id.*); and

21 WHEREAS, the National Center for State Courts has, likewise, identified
22 security drills as being essential part of best practices in court security;² and

23 WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court considers the safety of the public
24 and staff a priority and necessity to perform judicial functions; and

25 WHEREAS, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 3.025, the Chief Judge shall
26 prescribe the hours of the court.
