13 **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2017-08**

14 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 490 was signed into law by Governor Sandoval and
15 became effective on June 12, 2017;

16 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 490 requires the District Court to accept Petitions for
17 Foreclosure Mediation Assistance;

18 WHEREAS, this new case type will require administrative oversight to ensure
19 all fees are collected, mediators are appropriately assigned and the Rules for
20 Foreclosure Mediation adopted by the Supreme Court of Nevada are implemented; and

21 WHEREAS, the assignment of all Petitions for Foreclosure Mediation
22 Assistance to one judicial department in the general jurisdiction division will facilitate
23 priority calendaring and hearing of such petitions. This assignment will assist efficient
24 management by the court;

25 NOW THEREFORE,

- 26 1. Department One shall hear all Petitions for Foreclosure Mediation
27 Assistance for as long as the Chief Judge determines that the interests of the
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district court are promoted by the use of one docket assignment for these cases.

2. The Rules for Foreclosure Mediation adopted by the Supreme Court of Nevada will guide the management of these petitions by Department One. A subsequent Administrative Order will outline the District Court Foreclosure Mediation rules pending the Petition to Amend the Foreclosure Mediation Rules filed with the Supreme Court of Nevada on July 5, 2017.
3. The Filing Office is directed to reassign all pending cases for Foreclosure Mediation Assistance to Department One.
