DEFENDANTS SUBJECT TO PRETRIAL SUPERVISION.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018-11

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court Chief Judge has authority adopt rules and regulations as are necessary for the orderly conduct of court business (NRS 3.025(2)(c));

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court's Pretrial Services Division is responsible for the pretrial assessment and supervision of criminal defendants with the goal of minimizing failure to appear and re-offense;

WHEREAS, NRS 178.484 and NRS 178.4851 provide authority for persons arrested for a crime to be released with or without bail;

WHEREAS, NRS 178.484(11) provides that before releasing a person on bail, the court may impose release conditions on the person as it deems necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community;

WHEREAS, such release conditions may include a requirement that the person remain in a certain geographical location, a prohibition against contacting a specific person, or a prohibition from engaging in specific conduct that may be harmful to the health and welfare of the person or community members;

WHEREAS, NRS 178.484(13) provides that an order releasing a person on bail that imposes release conditions "must include a provision ordering any law enforcement officer to arrest the person if the officer has probable cause to believe that the person has violated a condition of bail";

WHEREAS, NRS 178.4851(1) provides that before releasing a person without bail, the court may impose release conditions on the person that "will adequately protect the health, safety and welfare of the community and ensure that the person will appear at all times and places ordered by the court";

WHEREAS, NRS 178.4851(6) provides that an order imposing "a condition on a person who is released without bail must include a provision ordering a law enforcement officer to arrest the person if the law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that the person has violated a condition of release"; and

WHEREAS, a person who violates the conditions of his or her pretrial release may present a risk to the health, safety and welfare of the community.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any Sheriff, Constable, Marshall, Policeman or Peace Officer who has the authority to effectuate an arrest within Washoe County, Nevada, may seize and detain any person being supervised by the Washoe County Pretrial Services Division, if there exists probable cause to believe that person has violated any previously imposed condition of pretrial release. Detention shall remain in effect until such time as a judge can address the violation.
