SCHEDULED COURT CLOSURES FOR THE PURPOSES OF STAFF SECURITY TRAINING.

AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018-14

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the District Court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c));

WHEREAS, the Conference of Chief Justices (CCJ) and the Conference of State Court Administrators (COSCA) have identified routine mandatory security training as being essential in increasing court security and emergency preparedness;¹ and

WHEREAS, the CCJ and COSCA instructed that security drills for all who work in a court facility are an important part of mandatory security training (id.); and

WHEREAS, the National Center for State Courts has, likewise, identified security drills as being essential part of best practices in court security;² and

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court considers the safety of the public and staff a priority and necessity to perform judicial functions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 3.025, the Chief Judge shall prescribe the hours of the court.

THEREFORE, the Second Judicial District Court shall close to the public on specified dates to conduct periodic security drills in an effort to better educate those who work in District Court facilities on emergency procedures to improve the safety of those who work in District Court and those who enter the District Court.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The Second Judicial District Court will close to the public at 3:00 p.m. on the following dates to conduct security drills:

January 18, 2019;

April 5, 2019;

August 9, 2019;

November 15, 2019;

January 17, 2020;

April 17, 2020;

August 21, 2020; and

November 20, 2020.
