CASE AND COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2019-04

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court Chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c)); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge shall assign cases to each judge in the judicial district (NRS 3.025(2)(a)); and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2018, Administrative Order 2018-16 was entered whereby Department 14 was assigned only minor guardianships, joint petitions without children, joint petitions with children, minor name changes, and emancipations; and

WHEREAS, under Administrative Order 2018-16, none of the above case types listed above were assigned to Departments 2, 11, 12, or 13; and

WHEREAS, under Administrative Order 2018-16, petitions for the termination of parental rights filed by private individuals were randomly assigned to Departments 11 and 12; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2018-16 was intended to be temporary in nature; and WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2018-16 is no longer necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Administrative Order 2018-16 is now rescinded. The following case types shall be distributed on a random basis to Departments 2, 11, 12, 13 and 14:
 - a. All marriage dissolution case types including annulment, divorce with children, divorce without children, foreign decree, joint petition with children, joint petition without children, separate maintenance;
 - b. Paternity;
 - c. Custody (non-divorce);
 - d. Non-Title IV-D support;
 - e. Visitation (non-divorce);
 - f. Termination of parental rights initiated by a private party;
 - g. Adoptions;
 - h. Minor name change;
 - i. Permission to marry;
 - j. Other domestic relation filing; and
 - k. Emancipation.
- 2. Cases involving the guardianship of a minor shall continue to be assigned to Department 14.
