ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-02(B) [OUT-OF-CUSTODY DEFENDANT CASES]

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court ("District Court") Chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c));

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2020-02 was entered on March 16, 2020 and Administrative Order 2020-02(A) was entered on April 9, 2020 by Chief Judge Scott N. Freeman; and,

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2020-02 provides, "This order shall be reviewed no later than every 30 days and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order." Administrative Order 2020-02, p. 4.

Accordingly, after review, and good cause appearing therefor, this supplemental Administrative Order 2020-02(B) follows:

This Order is intended to be consistent with the Declaration of Emergency in Nevada and to effectuate Governor Steve Sisolak's issued Directives resulting therefrom.

Due to the on-going health crisis caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, commencing May 18, 2020, the Second Judicial District Court will hear criminal dockets for out-of-custody defendants as follows:

Appearances will be conducted by audio/visual means in accordance with the Nevada Supreme Court Rules Governing Appearance by Audiovisual Transmission Equipment, Part IX. Participants are reminded these are formal proceedings and shall be conducted with proper decorum, and appropriate attire is required.

All provisions of Administrative Orders 2020-02 and 2020-02(A) shall remain in full force and effect except as specifically modified or supplemented here.

This Order shall be reviewed no later than every 30 days and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.
