**[UPDATED PRIORITIZATION OF TRIAL FLIGHT 3]
(TF November 16, 2020 – MTC October 28, 2020)**

**[AMENDMENT TO MTC DOCKET DATES AND
FINAL DATE FOR DECISION ON PRETRIAL MOTIONS]**

WHEREAS the Second Judicial District Court (“the District Court”) Chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c)) and incorporates all recitals set forth in Administrative Order (“AO”) 2020-02(E) as if set forth in full here; and,

WHEREAS AO 2020-02(E) provides, “[a] brief ‘Trial Flight Administrative Order’ for each TF will issue approximately eight (8) weeks before the scheduled TF identifying the trials set in the TF . . . and will state the trial prioritization”;

1 WHEREAS the first jury trial during the COVID-19 pandemic was heard during the week of
2 September 21, 2020 and a second jury trial commenced September 28, 2020; and,

3 WHEREAS the Court endeavors to continually improve the efficiency of the Trial Flight
4 process.
5

6 **Accordingly, and good cause appearing therefor, this Administrative Order 2020-**
7 **02(E)(TF 3)(A) follows:**

8 A brief "Trial Flight Administrative Order" for each TF will issue approximately eight (8)
9 weeks before the scheduled TF identifying the trials set in the TF and will state the trial prioritization.
10 The TF may change in the event a defendant invokes his speedy trial rights.
11

25 his designee, via audio/visual platform. Continuing forward, approximately three (3) weeks in
26 advance of each TF, a motion to confirm docket will be heard by the Chief Judge, or his designee.

1 For all trials set in TFs, the Judicial Department in which the case is assigned will rule on all
2 pre-trial matters. All motions must be fully briefed and submitted not later than twenty-eight (28)
3 days before the TF unless an earlier date is ordered by the assigned Judicial Department. *See*
4 *generally*, LCR 7. Decisions on the submitted motions will be entered twenty-one (21) days prior to
5 the TF.

7 The Chief Judge will determine whether the trial will proceed before the assigned Judicial
8 Department, or an alternate Judicial Department, in order to facilitate and maximize the number of
9 trials that may be resumed during the pandemic.
