ADMIN ORDER 2020-02(E)(TF 3)(A)

For all trials set in TFs, the Judicial Department in which the case is assigned will rule on all pre-trial matters. All motions must be fully briefed and submitted not later than twenty-eight (28) days before the TF unless an earlier date is ordered by the assigned Judicial Department. See generally, LCR 7. Decisions on the submitted motions will be entered twenty-one (21) days prior to the TF.
