ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021-01

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court ("District Court") Chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c)); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge shall assign cases to each judge in the judicial district (NRS 3.025(2)(a) and WDFCR 30(1)(e));

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court Family Division consists of 7 judges;
WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court Family Division has designated business
units, each overseen by a designated judge.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order 2018-06, Department 5, presided over by Judge Cynthia Lu, has been designated as the Child Dependency Department;

WHEREAS, effective January 4, 2021, Department 11, presided over by Judge Paige Dollinger, shall now be the designated Child Dependency Department; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for ease of administration to transfer all dependency cases and termination of parental rights cases filed by the Washoe County Human Services Agency in Department 5 to Department 11 and to transfer the caseload in Department 11 to Department 5.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Effective immediately, all open cases currently assigned to Department 11 shall be transferred to Department 5 and in accordance with WDCR 2(6).
- 2. Effective immediately, all closed cases filed 2002 or later, currently assigned to Department 11 shall be transferred to Department 5 and in accordance with WDCR2(6).
- 3. Effective immediately, all open and closed dependency and termination of parental rights cases filed by the Washoe County Human Services Agency currently assigned to Department 5 shall be transferred to Department 11.
- 4. Effective immediately, all open NRS 159A minor guardianship matters currently assigned to Department 11 shall be transferred to Department 14.
- 5. SCR 48.1(4)(a) provides that a peremptory challenge may be filed "within 3 days after the party or his attorney is notified that the case has been assigned to a judge." In all open case types, with the exception of dependency and termination of parental rights cases filed by Washoe County Human Services Agency, transferred pursuant to this order, a notice of case transfer shall be filed providing notice pursuant to SCR 48.1(4)(a). This Administrative Order shall be separately provided to the Offices of the Washoe County District Attorney, Public Defender and Alternate Public Defender. In addition, this

Administrative Order will be posted on the Court's website and forwarded to the Washoe County Bar Association for publication. If a party wishes to file a peremptory challenge, the challenge must be filed by January 21, 2021, or within three days after the notification is received, whichever is later, and assuming no evidence has been taken or any ruling made as described in SRC 48.1(4)(b).

- 6. The Presiding Judge may develop internal protocols, organizational restructuring, or court master assignments to implement this Order.
- 7. This Administrative Order shall be in effect until specifically modified or rescinded by subsequent Administrative Order.
