## ADMIINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021-07(B) (TS 4)

[RESUMPTION OF JURY TRIALS - CIVIL DOCKET]
[PRIORITIZATION OF TRIAL STACK 4 (June 29, 2021)]
WHEREAS the Second Judicial District Court ("the District Court") Chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c)) and incorporates all recitals set forth in Administrative Order ("AO") 2021-07 and AO 2021-07(A) as if set forth in full here; and,

WHEREAS AO 2021-07 provides, "[a]n abbreviated AO will issue setting the prioritization within each TS [Trial Stack]." AO 2021-07, p. 8; accord AO 2021-07(A), p. 2.

Accordingly, and good cause appearing therefor, this Administrative Order 2021-07(B) (TS 4) follows.


Counsel are directed to contact the Assigned Department to set the following:

- Status hearing to advise the Court if the parties have participated in a settlement conference;
- Final Calendar Call hearing ("FCC") to be heard on or about May 28, 2021 at which counsel shall confirm whether they intend to proceed with trial.

Pursuant to AO 2021-07, the Assigned Department will decide all pretrial motions on TS 4 cases. If the Assigned Department is not available to hear the trial, alternate departments will be polled for availability to hear the trial. AO 2021-07, p. 9.
