**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-06**

WHEREAS pursuant to NRS 62B.020, the Court shall appoint an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of the Second Judicial District Court to hear traffic offenses;

WHEREAS Mark Hill, Senior Juvenile Probation Officer, has been recommended to serve as an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of this Court;

WHEREAS Riley Killingsworth, Program Manager, has been recommended to serve as an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of this Court;

WHEREAS NRS 62B.020(3) requires any person appointed to act as a master of the juvenile court to attend the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges in Reno, Nevada training for new judges of the juvenile court on the first occasion such a course is offered after appointment;

WHEREAS NRS 62B.020(4) allows the Juvenile Court or the Chief Judge to appoint another qualified person to act temporarily as a master of the juvenile court during a period where the master who is regularly appointed is unable to act; and

1 WHEREAS Elizabeth Florez, Christine Eckles, Joseph Saiz, Taryn Bjelke, Mathew  
2 Banovich, Lance Mezger, Troy Harper, Rebecca Huddleston and Frank Cervantes have  
3 all previously served as Alternative Special Masters pursuant to NRS62B.020 and are  
4 qualified to act temporarily as an Alternative Special Master.

5 Based on the foregoing and good cause appearing therefor,

6 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

7 1. Mark Hill and Riley Killingsworth are each appointed Alternative Special  
8 Master of the Juvenile Traffic Offenders docket in the Juvenile Division of this Court.

9 2. If the NRS 62B.020(3) education requirement has not already been met,  
10 each Alternative Special Master appointed herein is ordered to attend training for new  
11 judges of the juvenile court at the next offering by the National Council of Juvenile and  
12 Family Court Judges.

13 3. The appointed Alternate Special Masters shall serve at the direction of the  
14 Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Division.

15 4. These appointments shall remain effective until specifically modified or  
16 rescinded by subsequent Administrative Order. And,

17 5. This order does not modify the appointments made in Administrative Order  
18 2021-02.
