11                           **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2023 –03**

13           WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS62B.020, the Court shall appoint an Alternative Special  
14 Master in the Juvenile Division of the Second Judicial District Court concerning traffic officers;  
15 and

16           WHEREAS, Jason Westphal and Stuart Muckel, Senior Juvenile Probation Officers, have  
17 been recommended to serve as an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of this  
18 Court; and

19           WHEREAS, NRS 62B.020(3) requires any person appointed to act as a master of the  
20 juvenile court to attend a course at the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges in  
21 Reno, Nevada, for training of new judges of the juvenile court on the first occasion such a course  
22 is offered after appointment; and

23           WHEREAS, NRS 62B.020(4) allows the Juvenile Court or the Chief Judge to appoint  
24 another qualified person to act temporarily as a master of the juvenile court during a period where  
25 the master who is regularly appointed is unable to act; and

26           WHEREAS, Elizabeth Florez, Christine Eckles, Joseph Saiz, Lance Mezger, Troy Harper,  
27 Riley Killingsworth, Mark Hill, and Frank Cervantes have all previously serviced as Alternative

1 Special Masters pursuant to NRS62B.020, and are qualified to act temporarily as an Alternative  
2 Special Master.

3 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

4 1. Jason Westphal and Stuart Muckel are hereby appointed Alternative Special  
5 Master of the Juvenile Traffic Offenders in the Juvenile Division of the Court; and

6 2. If the education requirement contained at NRS 62B.020(3) has not already been met  
7 the Alternative Special Master appointed herein is ordered to attend training for new judges of the  
8 juvenile court at the next offering by the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges;  
9 and


10 3. The above-named Alternate Special Master shall serve at the direction of the  
11 Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Division. This appointment shall remain effective until  
12 specifically modified or rescinded by subsequent Administrative Order.

13 4. Should the Alternative Special Master appointed under this Order be unable to act  
14 in this capacity, Elizabeth Florez, Christine Eckles, Joseph Saiz, Lance Mezger, Troy Harper,  
15 Riley Killingsworth, Mark Hill, and Frank Cervantes are hereby appointed to serve temporarily in  
16 this capacity.


17 5. This order supersedes all prior administrative orders on this point and shall remain  
18 in effect until modified by a subsequent order.
