ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-07

The Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District Court ("SJDC") has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court. WDCR 2(2); NRS 3.025(2)(c).

The SJDC previously accepted the filing of a single petition to compromise more than one minor's claim consistent with the provisions of NRS 41.200.

The SJDC previously had the ability through its case management system to track more than one minor identified in a single minor's compromise case with only one case number.

The SJDC is transitioning to a new case management system which does not provide the ability to track multiple minors who are identified in a single minor's compromise case.

To properly track each minor who is a party to a minor's compromise case in the new case management system, a single separate Petition must be filed and a new case initiated

1 for each minor identified in a minor's compromise case.

2 Accordingly, it is ordered that:

3 1. The SJDC shall require a single separate petition to compromise a minor's
4 claim be filed for each proposed minor subject to a minor's compromise claim.

6 2. The SJDC shall assign a new case number each time a Petition for Minor's
7 Compromise Claim is filed.
