13 Upon consideration by the Court and good cause
14 appearing, it is hereby Ordered that the Order entered on October
15 7, 1987, relating to the detention of status offenders at
16 Wittenberg Hall is amended as follows:

- 17 1. Exception number 2 of the Order is amended to provide
18 as follows: "Juveniles who are the subject of a warrant
19 of arrest."
20 2. Exception number 3 of the Order is amended to provide
21 as follows: "Juveniles who have run away from another
22 county or state; such juveniles may be held up to
23 twenty-four (24) hours for the purpose of determining
24 identity and the existence of wants for warrants, and to
25 locate parents or responsible adults and arrange for
26 transportation.


3. An additional exception is hereby added as follows:
Number 8. Juveniles who are students at the Sierra Nevada
Job Corps Center and whom the Sierra Nevada Job Corps
Center refuses to accept back into the program.

With the exception of the amendments provided herein, the
Order of October 7, 1987 shall remain in full force and effect.

In implementing this and the previous Order, law
enforcement officers responding to runaway and incorrigibility
calls from parents should encourage the use of citations rather
than booking the juvenile when appropriate.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
