10 Pursuant to Washoe District Court Rule 31(5), Orders for
11 Protection Against Domestic Violence, whether temporary, extended,
12 modified or other, are effective as of the date of entry by a
13 Court Master and notice to the parties. These orders do not
14 require the signature of a District Judge to become effective.
15 Any party may appeal to the Family Division of the Second Judicial
16 District Court from the terms of a Protection Order within ten
17 days of its service. Unless a stay of the order is obtained, it
18 remains in effect during the appeal period. If no appeal is
19 filed, the Protection Order is automatically ratified and
20 confirmed by this order.
