<u>ORDER</u>

Pursuant to Washoe District Court Rule 31(5), Orders for Protection Against Domestic Violence, whether temporary, extended, modified or other, are effective as of the date of entry by a Court Master and notice to the parties. These orders do not require the signature of a District Judge to become effective. Any party may appeal to the Family Division of the Second Judicial District Court from the terms of a Protection Order within ten days of its service. Unless a stay of the order is obtained, it remains in effect during the appeal period. If no appeal is filed, the Protection Order is automatically ratified and confirmed by this order.
