ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 07-01


This Administrative Order is made to rectify a current practice before the Second Judicial District Court - Family Division regarding the Order to Show Cause process. In recent years, requests for Orders to Show Cause, whether captioned as "motions" or "applications," have been considered ex parte although such treatment is not described in court rules. The Family Court Bench is concerned that this practice has been a source of confusion for lawyers and self represented litigants. The practice has also required judicial officers to hold hearings or to issue orders in order to obtain the views of non-moving parties. In an effort to make practice reflect existing court rules, the Family Court Bench orders that all requests for order to show cause; whether captioned as "motion,"


1 "application" or otherwise; shall henceforth be subject to court rules applicable
2 to motions.


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
