ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

It appearing that there is a variance of opinion as to the role of Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA's) in dependency 15 cases in which parental rights have been relinquished or 16 terminated and the subject child or children are pending 17 adoption; and it further appearing that the purpose of assigning 18 A CASA is to allow her/him to advocate for the best interests of 19 the minor child or children; and it further appearing that the 20 role of the CASA is therefore determined by the particular 21 bircumstances of each individual case in which a CASA is 22 assigned, and good cause appearing,

It is hereby ordered that in dependency cases in which 24 parental rights of both parents have been terminated or 25 relinquished and the subject child or children are being placed for adoption, the role of the CASA shall be determined as

| Follows:

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- 1. At the regularly scheduled periodic review or permanency 2 3 plan hearing held immediately after termination or relinguishment of the parental rights of the last parent, the Juvenile Master or District Judge presiding over such hearing shall make the following determinations:
 - A. Whether the best interests of the subject child or phildren require the continued presence of the CASA in the case;
- B. If the CASA is to remain in the case, any limitation 10 on the activity of the CASA:
- C. If the CASA is to remain in the case, any limitation pn access to information provided to the CASA by the Nevada State 13 Welfare Division or other individuals or agencies involved in the case.
- 2. The Nevada State Welfare Division, the CASA, or 16 pther interested party may request a special hearing to make the 17 Heterminations set forth above if such hearing appears necessary 18 under the circumstances of the particular case.
- 19 In making the determinations set forth above, 20 Duvenile Master or District Judge shall make every effort to protect the privacy and confidentiality of prospective adoptive 21 22 parents to the extent possible in light of the overriding purpose 23 of the Juvenile Court, Nevada State Welfare Division, and CASA 24 to promote permanency and to protect and serve the best interests

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1	of the minor child or children who are the subject of the action
