D <u>YES</u> –OR– _ <u>NO</u>	I am married.
E. <u>YES</u> -OR- <u>NO</u>	My parents or my legal guardian(s) allow me to live apart from them.
F <u>YES</u> –OR– <u>NO</u>	I am presently living apart from my parent(s) or legal guardian(s).
G. <u>YES</u> –OR– <u>NO</u>	I do not have any income from criminal activities.

If question A is answered "No", judicial emancipation is not possible in Nevada.

If **A** is answered "Yes", but one or more of the remaining questions are answered "No", then you should seek the assistance of a private attorney or attend the Family Law Lawyer in the Library Program. The Family Law Lawyer in the Library is at no cost and is held via Zoom; you must register ahead of time to participate. No walk-ins accepted as space is limited.
