8 in equity.

- 11 1. That the marriage existing between Petitioners be declared null and void and/or dissolved,
- 12 and the marriage treated as though it never occurred, and that we be granted an absolute
- 13 Decree of Annulment, and that we be restored to the status of single, unmarried person;
- 14 2. That the Court grant the relief requested in this Joint Petition; and
- 15 3. For such other relief as the Court finds to be just and proper.
