The penalty for willfully making a false statement under penalty of perjury is a minimum of 1 year, and a maximum of 4 years in prison, in addition to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00. N.R.S. §199.145.

A guardian will need to upload the original documents to eFlex. EFlex is available online at <https://wcefex.washoecourts.com/>, and at the Second Judicial District Court.

A guardian will need to sign into their eFlex account using the username and password they created and electronically file the:

Make sure to keep the original documents for your personal records. File-stamped copies of your documents are available through your eFlex account.

Scanners are available at the Second Judicial District Court.
