26 **The fee to file a peremptory challenge is non-refundable, even if your request is**
27 **denied.**
28 **If a judge has made a substantive ruling in your case, it is too late to change**
judges.

1 **There are strict timing requirements for filing peremptory challenges:**

2 **A peremptory challenge must be filed within 10 days of the parties being**
3 **notified that a trial or hearing date has been set or not less than 3 days**
4 **before the date set for the hearing of any contested pretrial matter,**
5 **whichever comes first.**

6 **If a case is not assigned to a judge before the time required for filing the**
7 **peremptory challenge, the challenge must be filed within 3 days after the**
8 **party or their attorney is notified that the case has been assigned to a judge**
9 **or before the jury is sworn, evidence is taken, or any ruling made in the trial**
10 **or hearing, whichever comes first.**

11 **It is your responsibility to know whether you can still successfully file a**
12 **peremptory challenge.**

13 **A new judge will be randomly assigned to your case; you do not get to pick who**
14 **the new judge is.**
