The refusal to obey a lawful order issued by the court is an act of contempt. NRS 22.010(3). If the act of contempt is committed outside the presence of the court, the facts constituting the contempt must be presented to the court through an affidavit or declaration. NRS 22.030(2); NRS 53.045. A person found guilty of contempt may be fined up to \$500 for each act of contempt, may be imprisoned for up to 25 days, or both. NRS 22.100(2). A person found guilty of contempt may also be required to pay the reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, of the person seeking to enforce the court's order. NRS 22.100(3).
