## AGENDA

A meeting has been scheduled for the Law Library Board of Trustees on Wednesday, February 8, 2017, at 5:00 PM in the Robert Z. Hawkins Boardroom in the Washoe County Law Library. The library is located in room 101 on the first floor of the Courthouse at 75 Court Street, Reno, Nevada 89501.

**NOTE:** Items on the agenda may be taken out of order; combined with other items; removed from the agenda; moved to the agenda of another later meeting; or may be voted on in a block. Items with a specific time designation will not be heard prior to the stated time, but may be heard later.

The Robert Z. Hawkins Boardroom is accessible to the disabled. If you require special arrangements for the meeting, call the Law Library at (775) 328-3250, at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting.

**Time Limits.** Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not, and are limited to three minutes per person. Additionally, public comment of three minutes per person will be heard during individual action items on the agenda. Persons are invited to submit comments in writing on the agenda items and/or attend and make comment on that item at the Board meeting. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

**Responses to Public Comments.** The Board of Trustees can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. During the public comment period, speakers may address matters listed or not listed on the published agenda. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the Board of Trustees. However, responses from Board members to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. On the advice of legal counsel and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the Board of Trustees will consider, Board of Trustees may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for staff action or to ask that a matter be listed on a future agenda. The Board of Trustees may do this either during the public comment item or during the following item: "Board Comment – Limited to Announcements or Issues for Future Agendas".

#### **INTERLIBRARY LOAN PROCEDURES**

#### Background

Interlibrary loan is a process in which a library requests to borrow material from another library or supplies material to another library. The purpose of the interlibrary loan transaction is to meet the informational needs of library users when local resources do not have the items available in their collection. The Law Library of the Second Judicial District Court supports this practice.

#### Process

- 1. If there is a need for an item that the Law Library does not have in the collection the Law Library staff will attempt to locate and request the material from another library. Patrons may place an interlibrary loan request in person, by contacting the Law Library Reference Desk 775-328-3250, or by submitting an email request on our website under "Ask a Librarian" located at <u>www.washoecourts.com</u>. Patrons must have a valid law library card and no outstanding fines or loans to request material through interlibrary loan.
- 2. Law Library staff requires a complete bibliographic citation for the item, this also applies to copies of articles or sections of a publication which the Law Library does not own. An example of a citation may include the following information; Author, title, edition, year, section, and/or page number. By supplying a detailed citation the supplying library is able to quickly locate and ship the item out. An incomplete citation may result in a delay in receiving the item.
- 3. The Law Library will contact local libraries first along with libraries that do not charge for interlibrary loans. If the material is not available locally, the library staff will access <u>www.WorldCat.org</u>; a free online catalog with collections worldwide. Once the item is located the Law Library staff will contact the lending library to inquire about the process to submit an interlibrary loan request to their organization.
- 4. Law Library staff may be asked to submit requests through The Online Computer Library Center (OCLC) system. The Law Library does not subscribe to the interlibrary loan section of OCLC; therefore interlibrary loan requests will be sent by email or through the lending library's website. Some libraries ask that an American Association of Libraries ILL Request Form be completed to request material.
- 5. The interlibrary loan request should include the name of Law Library staff submitting the request, the mailing address, and the email address of Law Library staff. Any special instructions such as particular edition or rush delivery should be included in the request. It is important to ask if there will be a charge associated with the loan.
- 6. If there is a cost to borrow the material, the Law Library staff will inform the patron of the cost and ask the library user if he/she wishes to proceed with the request. If the library user agrees to pay the charge for the loan, ask the lending library to include an invoice within the shipment. When the shipment arrives give the patron the invoice. The patron will contact the lending library and submit payment to them.
- 7. The loan period is determined by the lending library. The normal loan period is two weeks unless otherwise specified by the supplying library. The supplying library may recall the material at any time. If the library user requests additional time on the loan, the Law Library staff will communicate with the lending library to request an extension. If the extension is granted, the Law Library staff will inform the library user of the new due date. If the extension is denied, the material is to be returned immediately to the Law Library.
- 8. The Law Library is assuming responsibility of material received by the supplying library. The item shall be returned in the same condition as it was received. The library user will be charged for any damage or replacement costs of the item. Upon the return of the item to the Law Library, the Law Library staff will inspect the item to check for any damage. When shipping the item back to the lending library, the material shall be securely packaged to avoid any damage that may occur during shipping.
- 9. Library users are required to adhere to the Law Library's Interlibrary Loan Procedures. Repeated violations of these guidelines resulting in lost or damaged books, or not returning the books in a timely matter will result in the suspension of interlibrary loan service for the library user.
