- 3. Approval of Minutes from Board Meeting of December 5, 2018:

Honorable Scott Freeman made a motion to approve, Cortney Young seconded the motion; unanimous approval.

4. Update regarding the Law Library, including Lawyer in the Library Update, 2018 and 2019 statistics on volunteers, attendance, and topics covered; Law Library Statistics for 2018 and 2019, including statistics on number of patrons and the number and type of materials and resources used.

Project Homeless Count – 2 Law Library & 2 Filing Offer staff assisted 226 people.

Stats – down 472 in person from 2017-2018, 209 down over the phone. The Self-Help Center was up 1273 phone calls.

5. Discussion and possible action regarding the design of the Law Library space in the future Downtown Courthouse and the status of Downtown Court Master Plan with respect to the Law Library space.

There is a Downtown Washoe County Court Complex Master Plan that will be completed in May. It will assess DA, PD, HAS, Reno Justice Court, and SJDC needs and growth in the downtown area. Judge Hardy will present to the BCC on February 26, 2019.
