Hours of Operation:

Pretrial Services is closed to in-person services until further notice, but we are available via phone:

Monday – Thursday 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM

Friday 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM

Program Description: If release is granted, the Supervision Pretrial Services team ensures these defendants abide by the least restrictive conditions that have been imposed by the court.

Accessible Services and Support: Random drug and alcohol testing, Zoom check-ins, telephone check-ins, reinterviews, daily court notes and treatment/counseling guidance.

Summary of Services:

- This team provides supervision services to five of the seven local courts
- Approximately 2,160 individuals are supervised by this team, which equals almost 270 clients per pretrial officer.
- Approximately 20-25% of those cases are on the lowest level of supervision, only receiving a court reminder with no other condition imposed.
